

PUBLIC SIDEWALK SNOW REMOVAL

Freezing weather will soon be upon us. School children, seniors and persons with disabilities or physical challenges deserve clear, safe sidewalks to get around Troy. For those who rely on sidewalks to carry out their daily activities, it is important that sidewalks be clear of snow and ice.

Building occupants and property owners are responsible for clearing snow and ice from the public sidewalks adjacent to their property.

Snow and ice should be cleared from the sidewalks according to these standards:

- If the snow or ice stops falling during daylight hours, snow or ice should be cleared from the sidewalks within twelve (12) hours after.
- When snow or ice stops falling during the nighttime, it shall be cleared from the sidewalks by 6 pm on the following day.

If you are going away for a period of time, please make arrangements to have your sidewalks cleared while you are gone.
